



“Twirler of the Month”

One girl from the troupe is chosen for the honor of “Twirler-of-the-Month”. The “Twirler-of-the-Month” receives a gold baton pin that is to be worn on her uniform jacket at the annual banquet.

“Twirler-of-the-Month” Criteria:

- Appropriate practice clothes (leotard, shorts, knit pants, short-sleeve shirt), shoes (sneakers or jazz shoes, must be closed toe and heel - **NO Flip-flops**), and hair (must be pulled back out of the face), equipment (bring your baton!)
- Performance attendance
- Proper appearance for performances: in uniform (which is clean), head piece placed appropriately, hair pulled out of the face in a headband (short hair) or a bun (medium/long hair), minimal make-up (blush, clear lip gloss), no jewelry, no nail polish, baton tips cleaned, boots or sneakers cleaned, socks for younger girls, tights (optional but recommended) for older girls
- Shows up for practices/performances on time
- Exhibits positive attitude
- Attentive
- Respectful
- Good behavior
- Exceptional showmanship



“Show Group”

“Show Group” refers to the twirlers who will perform in a given event. All twirlers are always eligible and expected to perform. However, poor attendance and/or attitude may result in being removed from an upcoming performance.

PLEASE NOTE: The practice preceding a performance is ALWAYS mandatory in order to be eligible to perform in that event.
